Join us on Friday, June 28th to Celebrate the opening of our new Psychosocial Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Program (PRRTP) at the Erie VA Medical Center. The PRRTP is an 8-bed stand-alone unit with 24/7 staffing that is housed on the 6th floor of the main hospital. The program utilizes a mental health recovery model which includes empowering the Veteran to take ownership of their own recovery and meeting them where they are in their recovery process.

The Psychosocial Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Program (PRRTP) is a residential treatment program for male veterans:

- With a mental health and/or a substance use disorder diagnosis,
- Who desire and require care that is more intense than outpatient treatment and involves living on the unit temporarily,
- Are not experiencing acute psychiatric or medical problems that require an inpatient level of care.

Most Veterans in the PRRTP will require one to three months of treatment, but the length of stay is flexible and based on the needs of the individual Veteran.
